

## **Ebenezer and Rhoda Ford and family**

- 1829 - Birth of Ebenezer Ford, Bedhampton, 3<sup>rd</sup> June. Baptised 31<sup>st</sup> January, 1830.
- 1830 - Birth of Rhoda Arter, Havant, 14<sup>th</sup> September. Baptised 16<sup>th</sup> January 1831 by William Scamp.
- 1853 - Marriage of Ebenezer Ford & Rhoda, Portsea Island.
- 1857 - Birth of Frederick Charles Ford, Havant, 29<sup>th</sup> July.
- 1857 - Birth of Augusta Richmond Naillard in Horsham. Baptised 7<sup>th</sup> February 1858.
- 1859 - Birth of John Ford in Havant during the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter.
- 1861 - Birth of Walter Hurst Agate on Hayling Island. His father listed as a Miller in that year's Census.
- 1861 - Census - Ebenezer (a grocer) and Rhoda plus Frederick, aged 3 and John, aged 2, living in East St, Havant
- 1861 - Census - Augusta Naillard living with her parents Albert (a coachbuilder) and Hannah (nee Whittam) in North St, Horsham.
- 1862 - Birth of Annie Ford in Havant, 19<sup>th</sup> May.
- 1865 - Birth of Martha Pinker in Brighton.
- 1871 - Census - Ebenezer, Rhoda, Frederick, John and Annie living in South St. Ebenezer now listed as Grocer and Baker.
- 1871 - Census - Augusta listed at the home of an aunt and uncle in Horsham.
- 1871 - Census - Martha Pinker, her parents & siblings living at 10 Church St, Hove. Her father a Stonemason and Builder employing 5 or 6 men.
- 1871 - Census - Walter Agate living with his widowed mother a Baker and 2 sisters in Commercial Rd, Hayling (now South Rd).
- 1881 - Census - The Fords are now living in North Street, Havant. Ebenezer is listed as a Wine Merchant and John & Frederick are both Assistants.
- 1881 - Augusta listed in Partridge Green. Although described as a visitor she may have been working for the home owner, a Hotel Keeper, as her job is Bar Maid.
- 1881 - Census - Martha Pinker her parents & siblings living at 102 George St, Hove.
- 1883 - Death of Rhoda Ford in Havant, 4<sup>th</sup> June. Buried in the Dissenters cemetery, New Lane.
- 1885 - Marriage of John Ford and Augusta Richmond Naillard, Portsea Island.
- 1888 - Marriage of Frederick Douglas Ford & Martha Pinker in Havant.
- 1890 - Marriage of Annie Ford and Walter Agate on Portsea Island.
- 1891 - Census - Ebenezer Ford + one servant living at 10 The Pallant. Listed as Retired Grocer.
- 1891 - Census - John and Augusta at Prospect Farm, Havant in St John's parish. No children. One servant, a Carter, Solomon Rye. An interesting change from assistant in his father's wine merchants to farmer.
- 1891 - Census - Frederick, Martha and their son Frederick (born June 1<sup>st</sup> 1889) are living at The Limes. Frederick is listed as a Market Gardener. The Limes isn't shown on a contemporary map but is listed immediately before Prospect Farm Cottage.
- 1891 - Census - Annie & Walter are living at Brewery House, Horndean next door to The Ship and Bell which still exists and is on London Rd. Walter is a Draper.

1894 - Birth of Eveline Daisy Agate, Horndean, 27<sup>th</sup> July.

1901 - Census - Ebenezer is living at 2 Waterloo Rd, Havant with probably the same housekeeper.

1901 - John and Augusta still at Prospect Farm. No children.

1901 - Census - Frederick, Martha now styled Patty and Frederick jnr, listed as Douglas F, are also at Prospect Farm but listed as a separate household. Frederick probably listed as a Nurseryman but difficult to decipher as it's been written over.

1901 - Annie & Walter plus Eveline living at Westup House, Southbourne. The census form lists it between The Travellers Joy and St John's church, Southbourne. Walter is a Fruit Grower....

1907 - Death of Ebenezer Ford of 42 North St, Havant, 26<sup>th</sup> September. Buried in the Dissenters cemetery, New Lane, Havant.

1908 - Death of John Ford of Prospect Farm, North Havant. 28<sup>th</sup> November. Buried in the Dissenters cemetery, New Lane.

1911 - Census - Augusta is listed as a Visitor at 5 High St, Emsworth, the home of Annie, Walter and Eveline. Walter is back to being a Draper; Augusta listed as a Housekeeper.

1911 - Census - Frederick Charles & Pattie are living at Westwood, Fletching Common, Newick, Sussex. Frederick listed as a Fruit Grower.

1911 - Census - Frederick Douglas is a boarder with the Goodman family at Cobden House, Pavilion Rd, Worthing and is working as a Carpenter & Joiner, as is the Goodman's son.

1915 - Marriage of Frederick Douglas Ford and Dorothy Kate Pinker in Brighton. Dorothy born 21<sup>st</sup> February 1897 in Chelwood Gate, Sussex. Nearest town is Uckfield.

1921 - Census - Augusta living with her cousins Albert & Caroline Naillard (brother & sister) at Northblows Farm, Bines Green, south of Partridge Green, Sussex. Albert a retired farmer.

1921 - Census - Frederick & Pattie living at Wellingham, Ringmer, Sussex. Frederick listed as a Horticulturist.

1921 - Census - Annie, Walter and Eveline are still living at 5 High St, Emsworth. Walter listed as Draper (Retired).

1921 - Census - Frederick and Dorothy plus their children Eileen Mary (born 1918) and Nina Rosemary Bettie (born 6<sup>th</sup> January 1921) are living at Rotherfield, Newick, Sussex. Living with them are 3 Ford cousins. Frederick is listed as a Fruit grower.

1930 - Death of Walter Hurst Agate of Cambridge Villa, West St, Havant, 21<sup>st</sup> June.

1930 - Death of Augusta Ford of The Cottage, Finchdean, Hants, 21<sup>st</sup> November. Buried in the Dissenters cemetery, New Lane Havant.

1932 - Death of Martha "Pattie" Ford of Homestead Meadow, Wellingham, Ringmer, Sussex, 16<sup>th</sup> December. Buried 19<sup>th</sup> December in Ringmer.

1938 - Marriage of Eveline Daisy Agate and Horace John Munday in Havant. Horace a widower born 30<sup>th</sup> November 1862 had 4 adult children with his wife Mary who died in 1937

1939 - England and Wales Register - Frederick Charles Ford living at 7 Cannon Place, Brighton. Retired Farmer.

1939 - England and Wales Register - Annie is living at 154 West St, Havant with daughter Eveline and her husband Horace Munday, Builder (Retired).

1939 - England and Wales Register - Frederick and Dorothy plus daughter Nina R B are living at 8 Cannon Place, Brighton, i.e. next door to Frederick snr. Dorothy is listed as a Boarding House Keeper, Frederick a Florist and Nina, now listed as Bettie, an Unemployed Shop Assistant. I haven't been able to trace their other daughter Eileen beyond the 1921 Census.

1940 - Death of Frederic Charles Ford in Brighton. Buried in Ringmer, 27<sup>th</sup> March.

1947 - Death of Annie Agate of Cambridge Villa, 154 West St, Havant, 24<sup>th</sup> May.  
1955 - Death of Horace John Munday of 154a West St, Havant, 21<sup>st</sup> September. Buried 23<sup>rd</sup> September in plot 1110 of the Eastern Rd cemetery with his first wife. Grave still exists.  
1978 - Death of Eveline Daisy Munday of 71 Southleigh Rd, Havant, 8<sup>th</sup> March.  
1980 - Death of Frederick Douglas Ford of 2 Lewes Crescent Brighton, 27<sup>th</sup> March.  
1982 - Death of Dorothy Kate Ford of 2 Lewes Crescent, Brighton, 24<sup>th</sup> August.

PS. Nina Ford married a John G Hale in Brighton during 1945. They had 2 children both born in Brighton; Elizabeth R in 1946 and Stephen P in 1948. Nina died in Rottingdean, East Sussex in December 1982 and was buried there on January 4<sup>th</sup> 1983.
