## The Granville Family

This branch of the Granville/Grenfell family moved to Havant at some point between 1841 and 1845. Their money seems to have come from landholdings and tin mining in Cornwall.

1782. Baptism of George Brydges Glanville at St Pancras Old Church, Camden, London, 4<sup>th</sup> June. Brydges was his mother's maiden name.

1785. Birth of Fanny Hinchliff in Wandsworth, Surrey, 26<sup>th</sup> March. Baptised 4<sup>th</sup> May.

1792. Birth of Fanny's sister Ann(e) in Wandsworth. Baptised 7<sup>th</sup> June at St Mary's, Battersea.

1793. Birth of the third Hinchliff sister Catherine\* in Mitcham, Surrey, 18<sup>th</sup> September. Baptised 28<sup>th</sup> November in Mitcham. \* Occasionally spelt with a K.

1814. Marriage of George Brydges Glanville and Fanny Hinchliff at St Peter and St Paul, Mitcham, 31<sup>st</sup> August.

1815. Birth of Georgian Frances Granville in Southwark. Baptised at Christ Church, Southwark, 26<sup>th</sup> December.

1817. Birth of Eliza Ann Catherine Granville in Mitcham, Surrey. Baptised in Mitcham, 20<sup>th</sup> July.

1818. Birth of George Brydges Chamberlain Granville, baptised at St John the Baptist, Chester, 2<sup>nd</sup> September. George died on the 31<sup>st</sup> May 1836 and was buried at Chester Cathedral.

1819. Birth of Eleanor Charlotte Granville in Chester, baptised at St John the Baptist, Chester, 17<sup>th</sup> November.

1821. Marriage of Catherine Hinchliff and George Robert Mountain at Beddington, Sutton, Surrey, 22<sup>nd</sup> February.

1821. Birth of Charlotte Jane Granville in Chester, baptised at St John the Baptist, Chester, 1<sup>st</sup> August. Charlotte died on the 29<sup>th</sup> March, 1840 and was buried at Chester Cathedral, 3<sup>rd</sup> April.

1822. Birth of Thomas Williams Hinchcliffe Granville in Chester. Baptised at St John the Baptist, 8<sup>th</sup> February.

1823. Birth of Katherine Elizabeth Granville in Chester. Baptised at St John the Baptist, 4<sup>th</sup> August 1824. Katherine died on the 5<sup>th</sup> November, 1839 and was buried at Chester Cathedral on the 12<sup>th</sup>.

1824. Birth of Sarah Anne Granville in Chester, 8<sup>th</sup> November. Baptised at St John the Baptist, Chester, 21<sup>st</sup> August 1825.

## 1825. George Robert Mountain appointed Rector of St Faith's, Havant.

1826. Birth of Emma Creighton Granville in Chester. Baptised at St John the Baptist, Chester, 30<sup>th</sup> June. Family address is noted as Foregate Street which lies between the Cathedral and St John the Baptist.

1829. Birth of Robert Creighton Granville in Chester 7<sup>th</sup> February. Baptised at St John the Baptist, 25<sup>th</sup> March.

1841. The census list George and Fanny plus six children, three having died. George's occupation is Banker and their address given as Sealand, which is just to the west of Chester.

Katherine, sister Annie and their mother Elizabeth are living at Rock Buildings, South Bersted, Sussex.

Katherine's husband is living in South St, Havant presumably in the old vicarage.

**1845.** Death of George Granville in Havant, **12** September. Buried in St Faith's churchyard, **19**<sup>th</sup> September. George left a fairly comprehensive will but I can't see any mention of a property in Havant.

1846. Death of George Robert Mountain at Kidbrooke, Greenwich, 25<sup>th</sup> June. He is buried in St Faith's churchyard.

1847. Death of Eliza Ann Catherine Granville in Havant, buried in St Faith's churchyard, 2<sup>nd</sup> February.

**1848. Death of Fanny Granville in Havant. Buried in St Faith's churchyard, 23<sup>rd</sup> March.** Fanny's quite brief will mentions residing at Leigh but is no more specific than that.

1851. The census shows Georgiana, Sarah and Emma living with Katherine Mountain, now a widow, in South Hayling. All are of independent means.

Anne Hinchliff is living in South St, Havant with her niece Georgiana Hinchliff, two servants and a gardener. Anne described as a Landed Proprietress and Georgiana a Fundholder.

Thomas Granville is living on his own in Hagley, Worcestershire. Described as Land Proprietor and Fundholder.

1851. Marriage of Robert Granville and Caroline Hortense St Ledger Grenfell at the Cathedral Church, Gibraltar, 30<sup>th</sup> August. Robert listed as an Ensign in the Norfolk Regiment (9<sup>th</sup> Foot). They seem to have spent most of their married life abroad, so there is little information about them.

1853. Marriage of Thomas Williams Hinchcliffe Granville and Emily Orlebar at St James' Church, Husborne Crawley, Bedfordshire, 9<sup>th</sup> June. HC is about 4-5 miles from Woburn Abbey.

1857. Birth of Eleanor Katherine Granville in Havant, 20<sup>th</sup> November. Daughter of Robert and Caroline Granville, she was baptised at St Faith's, Havant on December 25<sup>th</sup>.

## 1860. Marriage of Georgiana Granville and William Pigott at St Faith's, Havant, 1<sup>st</sup> May.

1861. The Census shows Georgiana and William Pigott plus Sarah and Emma Granville and three servants living in Sydenham, Surrey. William's occupation, Master Mariner and Elder Brother of Trinity House.

Ann Hinchliff was living at Langstone Lane, Havant along with a visitor as well as a housekeeper and three servants. It's possible that that they may have been living in Woodfield – see map.



## Katherine Mountain was also living in Langstone Lane, possibly at Langbrook, along with a housekeeper and two servants.

Thomas and Emily Granville were living at Bexhill Lodge, Hilliers Hill, Bexhill along with a Cook and a House Servant. Thomas described as a Landed Proprietor.

Robert Granville is boarding at 37, Jermyn St, St James, Westminster. Listed as a Capt 26<sup>th</sup> Cameronians.

1867. Death of Emma Granville in Havant, 19<sup>th</sup> March. Buried in New Lane cemetery 26<sup>th</sup> March. Emma's address given as Langbrook, see map above. Sarah was listed as the sole executrix of Emma's will and was also living at Langbrook.

1869. Death of Emily Granville (nee Orlebar) in Leamington Spa, Warwickshire, 29<sup>th</sup> December. Buried at All Saints, Leamington Spa, 4<sup>th</sup> January 1870. Address Lansdowne Crescent.

1870. Death of Thomas Granville in Leamington Spa, 19<sup>th</sup> February. Buried at All Saints, Leaming Spa, 23<sup>rd</sup> February. Interestingly his address is given as Clarendon Crescent.

1870. Death of William Piggot in Burgess Hill, Sussex, 4<sup>th</sup> May. Buried 9<sup>th</sup> May at Norwood Cemetery, Lambeth.

1871. Census shows Sarah living with Katherine Mountain in Langstone, no house name given. Completing the household are a Cook, Parlour Maid, House Maid and a Kitchen Maid. The next entry on the same page is for Anne Hinchliff and G F Pigott, widow (aka

Georgiana). Completing their household is Anne MacKenzie, Visitor, a Housekeeper, a Cook, two Maids and a Footman.

1875. Death of Sarah Glanville at Lea Copse, Burgess Hill, Sussex, 20<sup>th</sup> April. Buried in New Lane Cemetery, Havant, 24<sup>th</sup> April. Georgiana was one of the executors of Sarah's will and her address was also Lea Copse. The other was their brother Robert whose address was, Hale, Winscombe, Somerset. Lea Copse still exists.

**1877.** Death of Katherine Mountain at Langbrook, Langstone, 2<sup>nd</sup> July. Buried at New Lane Cemetery, Havant, 6<sup>th</sup> July. Langbrook was still showing on an OS map published in 1966 but by 1968 it had gone following the development of Langbrook Close.

**1881.** Death of Anne Hinchliff at Woodfield, Langstone, 21<sup>st</sup> March. Buried at New Lane Cemetery, Havant, 29<sup>th</sup> March. Her executors were Georgiana and Anne's nephew Thomas Woodbine Hinchliff, a solicitor and son of her brother Chamberlain. Woodfield still exists but has been divided into flats.

1881. Census. Georgina living at Woodfield, Langstone. Other occupants are a Visitor, Sophia Field; a Cousin, Caroline Granville\*; a Coachman, Housekeeper and General Servant. \* Although listed as a Cousin, I wonder if this is Robert Granville's wife? Her age of 47 corresponds with Caroline's dob – 1834 and she is described as an Officer's Wife.

1889. Death of Georgiana Pigott in Havant, 25<sup>th</sup> October. Buried in New Lane Cemetery, Havant, 28<sup>th</sup> October. Her probate record shows that she was living at Langbrook at the time of her death.

1907. Death of Caroline Granville, wife of Robert, in Biarritz, Pyrénées-Atlantiques, France, 3<sup>rd</sup> June.

1910. Death of Robert Granville in Biarritz, Pyrénées-Atlantiques, France, 5<sup>th</sup> May.

1940. Death of Eleanor Katherine Naylor (nee Granville, born in Havant in 1857), in Nailsworth, near Stroud, Gloucs, 30<sup>th</sup> December. Her youngest child, Robert Francis Brydges Naylor was one of her executors.
