### WILLIAM JAMES ROBINSON

William was baptised 29th Dec 1872 in Sidlesham, the son of Joseph Robinson born about 1844 and Sarah Briant

William Robinson, 29, single, boarder, railway porter.

He married Caroline Hoad 29th Dec 1901, Selsey Parish Church  
Him 29, single, a railway porter of Selsey, her 38, widowed of Selsey.  
Fathers Joseph Robinson a labourer and George Sharpe a publican  
Witnesses Stephen Keeler? Henry Sharpe, Mary Ede, Annie Robinson

#### Child of William and Caroline

Charlie Robinson born 6th April 1903, baptised 14th June 1903 Selsey, married Olive Frances Clements 3rd quarter 1923 Portsmouth

William died 18th April 1908 in Havant Hospital from diptheria of 4 days, delirium, aged 35 yrs, buried New Lane Cemetery.
